

No Stencil Dry Embossing

Supplies:

Deco Designs Rubber Stamp Set (TAC)
Great Greetings Rubber Stamp Set (TAC)
Iris Palette Hybrid Ink Pad (Stewart Superior)
Purple White Core Cardstock (CTMH): cut to 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" folded in half and a 3 1/4" x 4 1/4" oval
White Ultrasmooth Cardstock (TAC): cut to 4" x 5 1/4" and a 1 3/8" x 1 7/8" oval
Purple Paper Flower (Prima)
Purple Mini Brad (All My Memories)
Purple 1/4" Ribbon (Offray)
Oval Cutting System (Creative Memories)
Embossing Stylus
Foam Mouse Pad
Corner Rounder (Carl)
Sanding Block (TAC)
Double Sided Tape (3M)



Instructions:

1. Cut all paper as stated in the supplies list. Use the corner rounder punch to round the corners of the large white piece.
2. Stamp the border on the top and bottom of the large white piece of cardstock using the Iris ink pad. Adhere a piece of purple ribbon in the center of this same piece. Adhere this finished piece to the purple card front.
3. Stamp the other curved border stamp on the back side of the purple oval piece using any ink. Lay this piece onto the mouse pad and using your stylus trace over all the lines firmly but not too hard to break through the cardstock. Flip the embossed oval over so the front side is up and swipe the sanding block over the raised images. With the white core paper you will get the white to show through only on the raised images. Not sanding your embossed image will leave you a more subtle look.
4. Stamp saying in the center of the small white oval using the Iris ink pad. Adhere this small oval to the center of the large embossed oval. Adhere the entire oval piece to the center of the card front.
5. Place a brad in the center of the flower and adhere the flower to the top of the small white oval on your card.
